# A BILL

For the relief of Alemseghed Mussie Tesfamical.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.
- 4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
- 5 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
- 6 1101 et seq.), Alemseghed Mussie Tesfamical shall be held
- 7 and considered to have been lawfully admitted to the
- 8 United States for permanent residence as of the date of
- 9 enactment of this Act upon payment of the required visa
- 10 fees.

### 1 SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.

- 2 Upon the granting of permanent residence to
- 3 Alemseghed Mussie Tesfamical, the Secretary of State
- 4 shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by 1, during the
- 5 current fiscal year, the total number of immigrant visas
- 6 available to natives of the country of the alien's birth
- 7 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality
- 8 Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
