2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FUNDING FOR KEWEENAW NATIONAL HISTOR-**  
4 **ICAL PARK.**

5 (a) MATCHING FUNDS.—Section 8(b) of Public Law  
6 102–543 (16 U.S.C. 410yy–7(b)) is amended by striking  
7 “\$4” and inserting “\$1”.

1 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section  
2 10 of Public Law 102–543 (16 U.S.C. 410yy–9) is amend-  
3 ed—

4 (1) in subsection (a)—

5 (A) by striking “\$25,000,000” and insert-  
6 ing “\$50,000,000”; and

7 (B) by striking “\$3,000,000” and insert-  
8 ing “\$25,000,000”; and

9 (2) in subsection (b), by striking “\$100,000”  
10 and inserting “\$250,000”.
