A BILL

To reinstate and extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project in the State of Illinois.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FEDERAL ENERGY
- 4 REGULATORY COMMISSION PROJECT.
- Notwithstanding the time period specified in section
- 6 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would

- 1 otherwise apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory Com-
- 2 mission project numbered 11214, the Commission may, at
- 3 the request of the licensee for the project, and after rea-
- 4 sonable notice, in accordance with the good faith, due dili-
- 5 gence, and public interest requirements of that section and
- 6 the Commission's procedures under that section—
- 7 (1) reinstate the license for the construction of 8 the project as of the effective date of the surrender 9 of the license; and
- 10 (2) extend the time period during which the li-11 censee is required to commence the construction of 12 the project for 3 consecutive 2-year periods beyond 13 the date that is 4 years after the date of issuance 14 of the license.
