- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Welfare Reform Exten-
- 5 sion Act of 2004".

1	SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF THE TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR
2	NEEDY FAMILIES BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM
3	THROUGH JUNE 30, 2004.
4	(a) In General.—Activities authorized by part A of
5	title IV of the Social Security Act, and by sections 510,
6	1108(b), and 1925 of such Act, shall continue through
7	June 30, 2004, in the manner authorized for fiscal year
8	2002, notwithstanding section 1902(e)(1)(A) of such Act,
9	and out of any money in the Treasury of the United States
10	not otherwise appropriated, there are hereby appropriated
11	such sums as may be necessary for such purpose. Grants
12	and payments may be made pursuant to this authority
13	through the third quarter of fiscal year 2004 at the level
14	provided for such activities through the third quarter of
15	fiscal year 2002.
16	(b) Conforming Amendment.—Section
17	403(a)(3)(H)(ii) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
18	603(a)(3)(H)(ii)) is amended by striking "March 31" and
19	inserting "June 30".
20	SEC. 3. EXTENSION OF THE NATIONAL RANDOM SAMPLE
