A BILL

To designate the Orville Wright Federal Building and the Wilbur Wright Federal Building in Washington, District of Columbia.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ORVILLE WRIGHT FEDERAL BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The Federal building located at
5 800 Independence Avenue, Southwest, in Washington,
6 District of Columbia, shall be known and designated as
7 the “Orville Wright Federal Building”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

1 States to the Federal building referred to in subsection
2 (a) shall be deemed to be a reference to the “Orville
3 Wright Federal Building”.

4 **SEC. 2. WILBUR WRIGHT FEDERAL BUILDING.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The Federal building located at
6 600 Independence Avenue, Southwest, in Washington,
7 District of Columbia, shall be known and designated as
8 the “Wilbur Wright Federal Building”.

9 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
10 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
11 States to the Federal building referred to in subsection
12 (a) shall be deemed to be a reference to the “Wilbur
13 Wright Federal Building”.
