Mr. CORZINE (for himself, Ms. COLLINS, and Mr. LAUTENBERG) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

# A BILL

To amend title 36, United States Code, to grant a Federal charter to the Irish American Cultural Institute.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. CHARTER FOR IRISH AMERICAN CULTURAL IN-4 STITUTE. 5 Part B of subtitle II of title 36, United States Code, is amended— 7 (1) by redesignating chapter 1001 as chapter 8 1003; 9 (2) by redesignating sections 100101 through

100110, and the items relating thereto in the table

- of sections, as sections 100301 through 100310, re-
- 2 spectively; and
- 3 (3) by inserting after chapter 901 the following
- 4 new chapter:

# 5 **"CHAPTER 1001—IRISH AMERICAN**

#### 6 **CULTURAL INSTITUTE**

# 7 **"§ 100101. Organization**

- 8 "(a) Federal Charter.—The Irish American Cul-
- 9 tural Institute (in this chapter, the 'corporation'), incor-
- 10 porated in New Jersey, is a federally chartered corpora-
- 11 tion.
- 12 "(b) Expiration of Charter.—If the corporation
- 13 does not comply with any provision of this chapter, the
- 14 charter granted by this chapter expires.

# 15 **"§ 100102. Purposes**

- 16 "The purposes of the corporation are as provided in
- 17 the articles of incorporation and include—

1	"(1) establishing the Museum of Irish America
2	in Washington, D.C., as the center of Irish Amer-
3	ican thought, dialogue, debate, and reflection;
4	"(2) recognizing and recording a living memo-
5	rial to the contributions of Irish-born and Irish
6	Americans to the development of the United States
7	"(3) providing a focal point for all Irish Ameri-
8	cans, who make up 17 percent of the United States
9	population, according to the 2000 census;
10	"(4) exploring past, current, and future events
11	in Ireland and the United States, as they relate to
12	Irish Americans and society as a whole;
13	"(5) documenting the tremendous contributions
14	of Irish immigrants to the United States in the
15	areas of architecture, military, politics, religion
16	labor, sports, literature, and art;
17	"(6) providing ongoing studies to ensure that
18	the experiences of the past will benefit the future of
19	both Ireland and the United States; and
20	"(7) establishing an Irish American Studies
21	Program for students from both Ireland and the
22	United States.

#### 1 **"§ 100103. Membership**

- 2 "Eligibility for membership in the corporation and
- 3 the rights and privileges of membership are as provided
- 4 in the bylaws.

#### 5 **"§ 100104. Governing body**

- 6 "(a) Board of Directors.—The board of directors
- 7 and the responsibilities of the board are as provided in
- 8 the articles of incorporation.
- 9 "(b) Officers.—The officers and the election of offi-
- 10 cers are as provided in the articles of incorporation.

#### 11 **"§ 100105. Powers**

- 12 "The corporation shall have only the powers provided
- 13 in its bylaws and articles of incorporation filed in each
- 14 State in which it is incorporated.

# 15 "§ 100106. Exclusive right to name, seals, emblems,

# 16 and badges

- 17 "The corporation has the exclusive right to use the
- 18 name 'Irish American Cultural Institute' and any seals,
- 19 emblems, and badges relating thereto that the corporation
- 20 adopts.

#### 21 **\*\*§ 100107. Restrictions**

- 22 "(a) Stock and Dividends.—The corporation may
- 23 not issue stock or declare or pay a dividend.
- 24 "(b) Political Activities.—The corporation or a
- 25 director or officer as such may not contribute to, support,

- 1 or participate in any political activity or in any manner
- 2 attempt to influence legislation.
- 3 "(c) Distribution of Income or Assets.—The in-
- 4 come or assets of the corporation may not inure to the
- 5 benefit of, or be distributed to, a director, officer, or mem-
- 6 ber during the life of the charter granted by this chapter.
- 7 This subsection does not prevent the payment of reason-
- 8 able compensation to an officer or member in an amount
- 9 approved by the board of directors.
- 10 "(d) Loans.—The corporation may not make any
- 11 loan to a director, officer, or employee.
- 12 "(e) Claim of Governmental Approval or Au-
- 13 THORIZATION.—The corporation may not claim congres-
- 14 sional approval or the authority of the United States Gov-
- 15 ernment for any of its activities.

# 16 "§ 100108. Duty to maintain tax-exempt status

- 17 "The corporation shall maintain its status as an or-
- 18 ganization exempt from taxation under the Internal Rev-
- 19 enue Code of 1986 (26 U.S.C. 1 et seq.).

# 20 **\*\*§ 100109. Principal office**

- 21 "The principal office of the corporation shall be in
- 22 Morristown, New Jersey, or another place decided by the
- 23 board of directors.

# 24 **Sample 100110. Records and inspection**

25 "(a) Records.—The corporation shall keep—

- "(1) correct and complete books and records of
  account;
- 3 "(2) minutes of the proceedings of its members,
- 4 board of directors, and committees having any of the
- 5 authority of its board of directors; and
- 6 "(3) at its principal office, a record of the
- 7 names and addresses of its members entitled to vote.
- 8 "(b) Inspection.—A member entitled to vote, or an
- 9 agent or attorney of the member, may inspect the records
- 10 of the corporation for any proper purpose, at any reason-
- 11 able time.

#### **12 "§ 100111. Service of process**

- 13 "The corporation shall comply with the law on service
- 14 of process of each State in which it is incorporated and
- 15 each State in which it carries on activities.

# 16 "§ 100112. Liability for acts of officers and agents

- 17 "The corporation is liable for the acts of its officers
- 18 and agents acting within the scope of their authority.

# 19 **"§ 100113. Annual report**

- 20 "The corporation shall submit an annual report to
- 21 Congress on the activities of the corporation during the
- 22 prior fiscal year. The report shall be submitted at the
- 23 same time as the report of the audit required by section
- 24 10101 of this title. The report shall not be printed as a
- 25 public document.".
