1	SECTION 1. FEDERAL RETIREMENT BENEFITS FOR EM-
2	PLOYEES OF CERTAIN CORPORATIONS
3	OWNED AND CONTROLLED BY THE UNITED
4	STATES.
5	(a) IN GENERAL.—Section 8331(1) of title 5, United
6	States Code, is amended—
7	(1) in subparagraph (K), by striking "and" at

20	(b) Technical and Conforming Amendment.—
21	Section 8401(11) of title 5, United States Code, is amend-

23	SEC. 2. CONTRIBUTIONS TO CIVIL SERVICE RETIREMENT
24	AND DISABILITY FUND.
25	(a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after the
26	date of enactment of this Act, the Director of Central In-

telligence shall make a payment described under sub section (b), from appropriations for the pay of employees
 of the Central Intelligence Agency, in an amount equal
 to—

5 (1)(A) employee contributions which would have
6 been deducted and withheld from the pay of individ7 uals described under subparagraph (M) of section
8 8331(1) of title 5, United States Code (as added by
9 this Act) for periods of service described under that
10 subparagraph, if that subparagraph had been in ef11 fect during such periods; and

(B) interest as prescribed under section 8334(e)
of title 5, United States Code, based on the amount
determined under subparagraph (A); and

(2) the amount of applicable agency contributions based on employee contributions under paragraph (1).

(b) DEPOSIT OF PAYMENT.—Payment of the amount
under subsection (a) shall be deposited in the Civil Service
Retirement and Disability Fund.

## 21 SEC. 3. REGULATIONS.

After consultation with the Director of Central Intelligence, the Office of Personnel Management shall prescribe regulations to carry out this Act, including regula-

tions that provide for, with respect to individuals affected
 by the amendment made by this Act—

3 (1) the application for, and computation or re4 computation of, annuities, including survivor annu5 ities; and

6 (2) the benefits payable if such an individual is7 not otherwise eligible for an annuity.
