Mr. REID introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Governmental Affairs

A BILL

To amend chapters 83 and 84 of title 5, United States Code, to provide Federal retirement benefits for United States citizen employees of Air America, Inc., its subsidiary Air Asia Company Limited, or the Pacific Division of Southern Air Transport, Inc.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 telligence shall make a payment described under sub-
2 section (b), from appropriations for the pay of employees
3 of the Central Intelligence Agency, in an amount equal
4 to—

5 (1)(A) employee contributions which would have
6 been deducted and withheld from the pay of individ-
7 uals described under subparagraph (M) of section
8 8331(1) of title 5, United States Code (as added by
9 this Act) for periods of service described under that
10 subparagraph, if that subparagraph had been in ef-
11 fect during such periods; and

12 (B) interest as prescribed under section 8334(e)
13 of title 5, United States Code, based on the amount
14 determined under subparagraph (A); and

15 (2) the amount of applicable agency contribu-
16 tions based on employee contributions under para-
17 graph (1).

18 (b) DEPOSIT OF PAYMENT.—Payment of the amount
19 under subsection (a) shall be deposited in the Civil Service
20 Retirement and Disability Fund.

21 **SEC. 3. REGULATIONS.**

22 After consultation with the Director of Central Intel-
23 ligence, the Office of Personnel Management shall pre-
24 scribe regulations to carry out this Act, including regula-

1 tions that provide for, with respect to individuals affected
2 by the amendment made by this Act—

3 (1) the application for, and computation or re-
4 computation of, annuities, including survivor annu-
5 ities; and

6 (2) the benefits payable if such an individual is
7 not otherwise eligible for an annuity.
