1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF SANTIAGO E. CAMPOS**
2 **UNITED STATES COURTHOUSE.**

3 The United States courthouse at South Federal Place
4 in Santa Fe, New Mexico, shall be known and designated
5 as the “Santiago E. Campos United States Courthouse”.

6 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

7 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
8 paper, or other record of the United States to the United
9 States courthouse referred to in section 1 shall be deemed
10 to be a reference to the “Santiago E. Campos United
11 States Courthouse”.
