1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

**3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.** 

4 This Act may be cited as the "Support Our Olympic5 Athletes Act of 2004".

6 SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY 7 RIGHTS OF UNITED STATES OLYMPIC COM-8 MITTEE.

9 Chapter 2205 of title 36, United States Code (com-10 monly referred to as the "Ted Stevens Olympic and Ama-

teur Sports Act"), is amended in section 220506(c)(3) by
inserting "the words 'Olympik', 'Olympick', 'Olympika',
'Olympicka', 'Olympica', or 'Olympikus'," after "the
words described in subsection (a)(4) of this section,".
