1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Support Our Olympic
5 Athletes Act of 2004”.

6 **SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY**
7 **RIGHTS OF UNITED STATES OLYMPIC COM-**
8 **MITTEE.**

9 Chapter 2205 of title 36, United States Code (com-
10 monly referred to as the “Ted Stevens Olympic and Ama-

1 teur Sports Act”), is amended in section 220506(e)(3) by
2 inserting “the words ‘Olympik’, ‘Olympick’, ‘Olympika’,
3 ‘Olympicka’, ‘Olympica’, or ‘Olympikus’,” after “the
4 words described in subsection (a)(4) of this section,”.
