3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Pactola Reservoir Re-

5 allocation Authorization Act of 2004".

- 6 SEC. 2. FINDINGS.
- 7 Congress finds that—

1 (1) it is appropriate to reallocate the costs of 2 the Pactola Dam and Reservoir, South Dakota, to 3 reflect increased demands for municipal, industrial, 4 and fish and wildlife purposes; and

5 (2) section 302 of the Department of Energy Organization Act (42 U.S.C. 7152) prohibits such a 6 7 reallocation of costs without congressional approval. 8 SEC. 3. REALLOCATION OF COSTS OF PACTOLA DAM AND 9 **RESERVOIR, SOUTH DAKOTA.**

10 The Secretary of the Interior may, as provided in the 11 contract of August 2001 entered into between Rapid City, 12 South Dakota, and the Rapid Valley Conservancy District, 13 reallocate, in a manner consistent with Federal reclamation law (the Act of June 17, 1902 (32 Stat. 388, chapter 14 15 1093), and Acts supplemental to and amendatory of that Act (43 U.S.C. 371 et seq.)), the construction costs of 16 17 Pactola Dam and Reservoir, Rapid Valley Unit, Pick-18 Sloan Missouri Basin Program, South Dakota, from irri-19 gation purposes to municipal, industrial, and fish and wildlife purposes. 20
