## A BILL

- To provide additional assistance to recipients of Federal Pell Grants who are pursuing programs of study in engineering, mathematics, science, or foreign languages.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

### **3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "21st Century Federal
- 5 Pell Grant Plus Act".

# SEC. 2. RECIPIENTS OF FEDERAL PELL GRANTS WHO ARE PURSUING PROGRAMS OF STUDY IN ENGI MEERING, MATHEMATICS, SCIENCE, OR FOR EIGN LANGUAGES.

5 Section 401(b)(2) of the Higher Education Act of
6 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1070a(b)(2)) is amended by adding at
7 the end the following:

8 "(C)(i) Notwithstanding subparagraph (A) and sub-9 ject to clause (iii), in the case of a student who is eligible 10 under this part and who is pursuing a degree with a major 11 in, or a certificate or program of study relating to, engineering, mathematics, science (such as physics, chemistry, 12 13 or computer science), or a foreign language, described in a list developed or updated under clause (ii), the amount 14 15 of the Federal Pell Grant shall be the amount calculated 16 for the student under subparagraph (A) for the academic year involved, multiplied by 2. 17

18 "(ii)(I) The Secretary, in consultation with the Sec-19 retary of Defense, the Secretary of the Department of 20Homeland Security, and the Director of the National 21 Science Foundation, shall develop, update not less than 22 once every 2 years, and publish in the Federal Register, 23 a list of engineering, mathematics, and science degrees, 24 majors, certificates, or programs that if pursued by a stu-25 dent, may enable the student to receive the increased Federal Pell Grant amount under clause (i). In developing and 26

updating the list the Secretaries and Director shall con sider the following:

3 "(aa) The current engineering, mathematics,
4 and science needs of the United States with respect
5 to national security, homeland security, and eco6 nomic security.

"(bb) Whether institutions of higher education
in the United States are currently producing enough
graduates with degrees to meet the national security,
homeland security, and economic security needs of
the United States.

"(cc) The future expected workforce needs of
the United States required to help ensure the Nation's national security, homeland security, and economic security.

"(dd) Whether institutions of higher education
in the United States are expected to produce enough
graduates with degrees to meet the future national
security, homeland security, and economic security
needs of the United States.

"(II) The Secretary, in consultation with the Secretary of Defense, the Secretary of the Department of
Homeland Security, and the Secretary of State, shall develop, update not less than once every 2 years, and publish
in the Federal Register, a list of foreign language degrees,

1 majors, certificates, or programs that if pursued by a stu2 dent, may enable the student to receive the increased Fed3 eral Pell Grant amount under clause (i). In developing and
4 updating the list the Secretaries shall consider the fol5 lowing:

6 "(aa) The foreign language needs of the United
7 States with respect to national security, homeland
8 security, and economic security.

9 "(bb) Whether institutions of higher education
10 in the United States are currently producing enough
11 graduates with degrees to meet the national security,
12 homeland security, and economic security needs of
13 the United States.

"(cc) The future expected workforce needs of
the United States required to help ensure the Nation's national security, homeland security, and economic security.

"(dd) Whether institutions of higher education
in the United States are expected to produce enough
graduates with degrees to meet the future national
security, homeland security, and economic security
needs of the United States.

23 "(iii) Each student who received an increased Federal
24 Pell Grant amount under clause (i) to pursue a degree,
25 major, certificate, or program described in a list published

under subclause (I) or (II) of clause (ii) shall continue
 to be eligible for the increased Federal Pell Grant amount
 in subsequent academic years if the degree, major, certifi cate, or program, respectively, is subsequently removed
 from the list.

6 "(iv)(I) If a student who received an increased Fed-7 eral Pell Grant amount under clause (i) changes the stu-8 dent's course of study to a degree, major, certificate, or program that is not included in a list described in clause 9 10 (ii), then the Secretary shall reduce the amount of Federal Pell Grant assistance the student is eligible to receive 11 12 under this section for subsequent academic years by an 13 amount equal to the difference between the total amount the student received under this subparagraph and the 14 15 total amount the student would have received under this section if this subparagraph had not been applied. 16

17 "(II) The Secretary shall reduce the amount of Federal Pell Grant assistance the student is eligible to receive 18 in subsequent academic years by dividing the total amount 19 20 to be reduced under subclause (I) for the student by the 21 number of years the student received an increased Federal 22 Pell Grant amount under clause (i), and deducting the re-23 sult from the amount of Federal Pell Grant assistance the 24 student is eligible to receive under this section for a num-25 ber of subsequent academic years equal to the number of

- 1 academic years the student received an increased Federal
- 2 Pell Grant amount under clause (i).".
