## A BILL

To redesignate the Colonnade Center in Denver, Colorado, as the “Cesar E. Chavez Memorial Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF CESAR E. CHAVEZ MEMORIAL**  
4 **BUILDING.**

5 The building known as the “Colonnade Center”, lo-  
6 cated at 1244 Speer Boulevard in Denver, Colorado, shall  
7 be known and designated as the “Cesar E. Chavez Memo-  
8 rial Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2       Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,  
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the building  
4 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference  
5 to the Cesar E. Chavez Memorial Building.
