Mrs. FEINSTEIN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Denes and Gyorgyi Fulop.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR DENES**
4 **AND GYORGYI FULOP.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)
6 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality
7 Act, Denes and Gyorgyi Fulop shall be eligible for
8 issuance of immigrant visas or for adjustment of status
9 to that of aliens lawfully admitted for permanent residence
10 upon filing an application for issuance of immigrant visas
11 under section 204 of such Act or for adjustment of status
12 to lawful permanent resident.

1 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Denes Fulop or
 2 Gyorgyi Fulop enters the United States before the filing
 3 deadline specified in subsection (c), the alien shall be con-
 4 sidered to have entered and remained lawfully and shall,
 5 if otherwise eligible, be eligible for adjustment of status
 6 under section 245 of the Immigration and Nationality Act
 7 as of the date of enactment of this Act.

8 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
 9 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-
 10 plication for issuance of immigrant visas or the application
 11 for adjustment of status are filed with appropriate fees
 12 within 2 years after the date of enactment of this Act.

13 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBERS.—
 14 Upon the granting of immigrant visas or permanent resi-
 15 dence to Denes and Gyorgyi Fulop, the Secretary of State
 16 shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by the appro-
 17 priate number, during the current or next following fiscal
 18 year, the total number of immigrant visas that are made
 19 available to natives of the country of the aliens' birth
 20 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality
 21 Act or, if applicable, the total number of immigrant visas
 22 that are made available to natives of the country of the
 23 aliens' birth under section 202(e) of such Act.
