5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 218(d)(6)(C) of the Social
6 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 418(d)(6)(C)) is amended by in-
7 serting “Kentucky,” after “Illinois,”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
9 subsection (a) takes effect on January 1, 2003.
