- 5 (a) In General.—Section 8415 of title 5, United
- 6 States Code, is amended—
- 7 (1) by redesignating the second subsection (i)
- 8 as subsection (k); and

- 1 (2) by adding at the end the following:
- 2 "(1) In the case of any annuity computation under
- 3 this section that includes, in the aggregate, at least 2
- 4 months of credit under section 8411(d) for any period
- 5 while receiving benefits under subchapter I of chapter 81,
- 6 the percentage otherwise applicable under this section for
- 7 that period so credited shall be increased by 1 percentage
- 8 point.".
- 9 (b) Conforming Amendment.—Section 8422(d)(2)
- 10 of title 5, United States Code (as added by section
- 11 122(b)(2) of Public Law 107–135), is amended by striking
- 12 "8415(i)" and inserting "8415(k)".
- 13 (c) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by this
- 14 section shall apply with respect to any annuity entitlement
- 15 which is based on a separation from service occurring on
- 16 or after the date of enactment of this Act.
