- 8 (a) In General.—The Secretary of the Army is au-
- 9 thorized to carry out, under section 111 of the River and

- 1 Harbor Act of 1968 (33 U.S.C. 426i), a project for the
- 2 mitigation of shore damages attributable to the project for
- 3 navigation, Saco River, Maine.
- 4 (b) Cost-Benefit Ratio.—Congress finds that the
- 5 overall benefits of the mitigation project carried out under
- 6 subsection (a) exceed the costs of the mitigation project.
