3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Camp Ellis Beach Res-
5 toration Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. SHORE DAMAGE MITIGATION PROJECT, SACO**
7 **RIVER, MAINE.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Army is au-
9 thorized to carry out, under section 111 of the River and

1 Harbor Act of 1968 (33 U.S.C. 426i), a project for the
2 mitigation of shore damages attributable to the project for
3 navigation, Saco River, Maine.

4 (b) COST-BENEFIT RATIO.—Congress finds that the
5 overall benefits of the mitigation project carried out under
6 subsection (a) exceed the costs of the mitigation project.
