# AN ACT

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to study certain sites in the historic district of Beaufort, South Carolina, relating to the Reconstruction Era.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Beaufort County,
- 5 South Carolina, Study Act of 2003".

### 1 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.

2	In this Act:
3	(1) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
4	the Secretary of the Interior.
5	(2) Study area.—The term "study area"
6	means the historical sites in Beaufort County, South
7	Carolina, relating to the Reconstruction Era includ-
8	ing—
9	(A) the Penn School;
10	(B) the Old Fort Plantation on the Beau-
11	fort River;
12	(C) the Freedman's Bureau in Beaufort
13	College;
14	(D) the first Freedman's Village of
15	Mitchellville on Hilton Head Island;
16	(E) various historic buildings and archae-
17	ological sites associated with Robert Smalls;
18	(F) the Beaufort Arsenal; and
19	(G) other significant sites relating to the
20	Reconstruction Era.
21	SEC. 3. SPECIAL RESOURCE STUDY.
22	(a) Study.—The Secretary shall conduct a special
23	resource study of the study area to assess the national
24	significance, suitability and feasibility of designating the
25	study area as a unit of the National Park System in ac-

- 1 cordance with section 8(c) of Public Law 91–383 (16
- 2 U.S.C. 1a-5(c)).
- 3 (b) Report.—Not later than 3 years after the date
- 4 on which funds are made available to carry out the special
- 5 resource study, the Secretary shall submit to Congress a
- 6 report that describes the findings of the study and any
- 7 conclusions and recommendations of the Secretary.

#### 8 SEC. 4. THEME STUDY.

- 9 (a) Study.—The Secretary shall conduct a national
- 10 historic landmark theme study to identify sites and re-
- 11 sources in the United States that are significant to the
- 12 Reconstruction Era, and shall include recommendations
- 13 for commemorating and interpreting sites and resources
- 14 identified by the theme study such as sites that should
- 15 be nominated as national historic landmarks and sites that
- 16 warrant further study for potential inclusion in the Na-
- 17 tional Park System.
- 18 (b) Report.—Not later than 3 years after the date
- 19 on which funds are made available to carry out the theme
- 20 study, the Secretary shall submit to the Congress a report
- 21 that describes the findings of the study and any conclu-
- 22 sions and recommendations of the Secretary.

### 1 SEC. 5. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

- There are authorized to be appointed such sums as
- 3 are necessary to carry out this Act.
