Mrs. Boxer introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Environment and Public Works

A BILL

To amend the Safe Drinking Water Act to designate perchlorate as a contaminant and to establish a maximum contaminant level for perchlorate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. MAXIMUM CONTAMINANT LEVEL FOR PERCHLORATE.

Section 1412(b)(12) of the Safe Drinking Water Act
(42 U.S.C. 300g–1(b)(12)) is amended by adding at the
end the following:

"(C) PERCHLORATE.—

"(i) DECLARATION OF PERCHLORATE

AS CONTAMINANT.—Congress declares that

1	perchlorate is a contaminant subject to
2	regulation under this title.
3	"(ii) Maximum contaminant
4	LEVEL.—Not later than July 1, 2004, the
5	Administrator shall establish a maximum
6	contaminant level for perchlorate that pro-
7	vides an adequate margin of safety for vul-
8	nerable populations (including children and
9	pregnant women).
10	"(iii) Regulation.—On and after
11	the date of establishment of the maximum
12	contaminant level under clause (ii), the Ad-
13	ministrator shall regulate perchlorate as an
14	inorganic contaminant in accordance with
15	part 141 of title 40, Code of Federal Regu-
16	lations (or a successor regulation).".
