## A BILL

For the relief of Donald C. Pence.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RELIEF OF DONALD C. PENCE.**

4 (a) RELIEF.—The Secretary of the Treasury shall  
5 pay, out of any moneys in the Treasury not otherwise ap-  
6 propriated, to Donald C. Pence, of Sanford, North Caro-  
7 lina, the sum of \$31,128 in compensation for the failure  
8 of the Department of Veterans Affairs to pay dependency  
9 and indemnity compensation to Kathryn E. Box, the now-  
10 deceased mother of Donald C. Pence, for the period begin-  
11 ning on July 1, 1990, and ending on March 31, 1993.

1       (b) LIMITATION ON FEES.—Not more than a total  
2 of 10 percent of the payment authorized by subsection (a)  
3 shall be paid to or received by agents or attorneys for serv-  
4 ices rendered in connection with obtaining such payment,  
5 any contract to the contrary notwithstanding. Any person  
6 who violates this subsection shall be fined not more than  
7 \$1,000.
