AN ACT

To require the construction at Arlington National Cemetery of a memorial to the crew of the Columbia Orbiter.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Columbia Orbiter Me-

5 morial Act".

1 SEC. 2. CONSTRUCTION OF MEMORIAL TO CREW OF CO 2 LUMBIA ORBITER AT ARLINGTON NATIONAL 3 CEMETERY.

4 (a) CONSTRUCTION REQUIRED.—The Secretary of 5 the Army shall, in consultation with the Administrator of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, con-6 7 struct at an appropriate place in Arlington National Cem-8 etery, Virginia, a memorial marker honoring the seven 9 members of the crew of the Columbia Orbiter who died on February 1, 2003, over the State of Texas during the 10 11 landing of space shuttle mission STS-107.

(b) AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS.—Of the amount appropriated or otherwise made available by title II of the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2003 (Public
Law 107–248) under the heading "OPERATION AND
MAINTENANCE, ARMY", \$500,000 shall be available for
the construction of the memorial marker required by subsection (a).

19 SEC. 3. DONATIONS FOR MEMORIAL FOR CREW OF COLUM20 BIA ORBITER.

(a) AUTHORITY TO ACCEPT DONATIONS.—The Administrator of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration may accept gifts and donations of services,
money, and property (including personal, tangible, or intangible property) for the purpose of an appropriate memorial or monument to the seven members of the crew

of the Columbia Orbiter who died on February 1, 2003,
 over the State of Texas during the landing of space shuttle
 mission STS-107, whether such memorial or monument
 is constructed by the Administrator or is the memorial
 marker required by section 2.

6 (b) TRANSFER.—(1) The Administrator may transfer
7 to the Secretary of the Army any services, money, or prop8 erty accepted by the Administrator under subsection (a)
9 for the purpose of the construction of the memorial mark10 er required by section 2.

11 (2) Any moneys transferred to the Secretary under 12 paragraph (1) shall be merged with amounts in the ac-13 count referred to in subsection (b) of section 2, and shall be available for the purpose referred to in that subsection. 14 15 (c) EXPIRATION OF AUTHORITY.—The authority of the Administrator to accept gifts and donations under 16 17 subsection (a) shall expire five years after the date of the enactment of this Act. 18
