A BILL

To amend the National Trails System Act to require the Secretary of the Interior to update the feasibility and suitability studies of four national historic trails, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
2	This Act may be cited as the "Pioneer National His-
3	torie Trails Studies Act''.
4	SEC. 2. REVISION OF FEASIBILITY AND SUITABILITY STUD
5	IES OF EXISTING NATIONAL HISTORIC
6	TRAILS.
7	The National Trails System Act is amended by in-
8	serting after section 5 (16 U.S.C. 1244) the following new
9	section:
10	"SEC. 5A. REVISION OF FEASIBILITY AND SUITABILITY
11	STUDIES OF EXISTING TRAILS FOR POSSIBLE
12	TRAIL EXPANSION.
13	"(a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
14	"(1) ROUTE.—The term 'route' includes a trai
15	segment commonly known as a cutoff.
16	"(2) SHARED ROUTE.—The term 'shared route
17	means a route that was a segment of more than one
18	historic trail, including a route shared with an exist-
19	ing national historic trail.
20	"(b) GENERAL RULES.—
21	"(1) STUDY REQUIREMENTS AND OBJEC-
22	TIVES.—The study requirements and objectives spec-
23	ified in section 5(b) shall apply to a study required
24	by this section.
25	"(2) Completion and submission of

STUDY.—Not later than three complete fiscal years

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- 1 after the date of the enactment of this section, the
- 2 Secretary shall complete and submit to Congress the
- 3 studies required by subsections (e) through (g). In
- 4 the case of a study added to this section after that
- 5 date, the study shall be completed and submitted to
- 6 Congress not later than three complete fiscal years
- 7 after the date of the enactment of the law adding
- 8 the study to this section.
- 9 "(e) Oregon National Historic Trail.—The
- 10 Secretary of the Interior shall undertake a study of the
- 11 routes of the Oregon Trail, as generally depicted on the
- 12 map entitled 'Western Emigrant Trails 1830/1870' and
- 13 dated 1991/1993, and such other routes of the Oregon
- 14 Trail that the Secretary considers appropriate, to deter-
- 15 mine the feasibility and suitability of designation of one
- 16 or more of the routes as components of the Oregon Na-
- 17 tional Historie Trail. The routes to be studied under this

19	and western routes that the Secretary considers appro-
20	priate, to determine the feasibility and suitability of des-

11	SECTION 1. REVISION OF FEASIBILITY AND SUITABILITY
12	STUDIES OF EXISTING NATIONAL HISTORIC
13	TRAILS.
14	Section 5 of the National Trails System Act (16 U.S.C.
15	1244) is amended by inserting the following new subsection:
16	"(g) The Secretary shall revise the feasibility and suit-
17	ability studies for certain national trails for consideration
18	of possible additions to the trails.
19	"(1) In General.—
20	"(A) Definitions.—In this subsection:
21	"(i) Route.—The term 'route' includes
22	a trail segment commonly known as a cut-
23	off.
24	"(ii) Shared route.—The term
25	'shared route' means a route that was a seg-

1 ment of more than one historic trail, in-2 cluding a route shared with an existing na-3 tional historic trail.

- "(B) STUDY REQUIREMENTS AND OBJECTIVES.—The study requirements and objectives specified in subsection (b) shall apply to a study required by this subsection.
- "(C) COMPLETION AND SUBMISSION OF STUDY.—A study listed in this subsection shall be completed and submitted to the Congress not later than three complete fiscal years from the date funds are made available for the study.

"(2) Oregon national historic trail.—

"(A) STUDY REQUIRED.—The Secretary of the Interior shall undertake a study of the routes of the Oregon Trail listed in subparagraph (B) and generally depicted on the map entitled Western Emigrant Trails 1830/1870' and dated 1991/1993, and of such other routes of the Oregon Trail that the Secretary considers appropriate, to determine the feasibility and suitability of designation of one or more of the routes as components of the Oregon National Historic Trail.
