AN ACT

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior, in cooperation with the University of New Mexico, to construct and occupy a portion of the Hibben Center for Archaeological Research at the University of New Mexico, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Hibben Center Act".

1 SEC. 2. LEASE AGREEMENT.

- 2 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary of the Interior
- 3 may enter into an agreement with the University of New
- 4 Mexico to lease space in the Hibben Center for Archae-
- 5 ological Research at the University of New Mexico for re-
- 6 search on, and curation of, the archaeological research col-
- 7 lections of the National Park Service relating to the Chaco
- 8 Culture National Historical Park and Aztec Ruins Na-
- 9 tional Monument.
- 10 (b) TERM; RENT.—The lease shall provide for a term
- 11 not exceeding 40 years and a nominal annual lease pay-
- 12 ment.
- 13 (c) Operating Expenses.—The lease may require
- 14 the Secretary to contribute a pro rata share of the Hibben
- 15 Center's annual operating expenses, in addition to any
- 16 nominal annual rent.
- 17 (d) Improvements.—The lease shall permit the Sec-
- 18 retary to make improvements and install furnishings and
- 19 fixtures related to the use and curation of the collections.
- 20 **SEC. 3. GRANT.**
- Upon execution of the lease, the Secretary may con-
- 22 tribute to the University of New Mexico up to 37 percent
- 23 of the cost of construction of the Hibben Center, not to
- 24 exceed \$1,750,000.

1 SEC. 4. COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT.

- 2 The Secretary may enter into cooperative agreements
- 3 with the University of New Mexico, Federal agencies, and
- 4 Indian tribes for the curation of and conduct of research
- 5 on artifacts, and to encourage collaborative management
- 6 of the Chacoan archaeological artifacts associated with
- 7 northwestern New Mexico.
- 8 SEC. 5. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.
- 9 There are authorized to be appropriated to the Sec-
- 10 retary such sums as may be necessary for the purposes
- 11 of this Act.
