3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF CARL T. CURTIS NATIONAL**
4 **PARK SERVICE MIDWEST REGIONAL HEAD-**
5 **QUARTERS BUILDING.**

6 The regional headquarters building for the National
7 Park Service under construction in Omaha, Nebraska,
8 shall be known and designated as the “Carl T. Curtis Na-

1 tional Park Service Midwest Regional Headquarters
2 Building”.

3 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

4 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
5 paper, or other record of the United States to the regional
6 headquarters building referred to in section 1 shall be
7 deemed to be a reference to the Carl T. Curtis National
8 Park Service Midwest Regional Headquarters Building.
