## A BILL

To prevent the pretrial release of those who rape or kidnap  
children, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. NO PRETRIAL RELEASE FOR THOSE WHO RAPE**

4                       **OR KIDNAP CHILDREN.**

5       Section 3142(e) of title 18, United States Code, is  
6       amended by striking “or 2332b” and inserting “1201,  
7       1591, 2241, 2242, 2244(a)(1), 2244(a)(2), 2251, 2251A,  
8       2252, 2252A, 2260, 2332b, 2421, 2422, 2423, or 2425”.

1 **SEC. 2. SUZANNE'S LAW.**

2       Section 3701(a) of the Crime Control Act of 1990  
3 (42 U.S.C. 5779(a)) is amended by striking “age of 18”  
4 and inserting “age of 21”.
