All action in the line of duty by, and all Federal agency actions in relation to (including with respect to pay,
benefits, and retirement) a de facto officer of the commis-

1 sioned corps of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Ad-2 ministration who was appointed or promoted to that office without Presidential action, and without the advice and 3 4 consent of the Senate, during such time as the officer was 5 not properly appointed in or promoted to that office, are hereby ratified and approved if otherwise in accord with 6 7 the law, and the President alone may, without regard to any other law relating to appointments or promotions in 8 9 such corps, appoint or promote such a de facto officer temporarily, without change in the grade currently occupied 10 in a de facto capacity, as an officer in such corps for a 11 12 period ending not later than 180 days from the date of 13 enactment of this Act.
