## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the use of the rotunda of the Capitol for the lying in state of the remains of the late Ronald Wilson Reagan, 40th President of the United States.

1       *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*  
2 *concurring)*, That in recognition of the long and distin-  
3 guished service rendered to the Nation and to the world  
4 by the late Ronald Wilson Reagan, the 40th President of  
5 the United States, his remains be permitted to lie in state  
6 in the rotunda of the Capitol from June 9 until June 11,  
7 2004, and the Architect of the Capitol, under the direction  
8 of the President pro tempore of the Senate and the Speak-

- 1 er of the House of Representatives, shall take all necessary
- 2 steps for the accomplishment of that purpose.
