RESOLUTION

Relative to the death of Russell B. Long, former United
States Senator for the State of Louisiana.

Whereas Russell B. Long served in the United States Navy
from 1942 to 1945;

Whereas Russell B. Long succeeded both his parents as
members of the United States Senate;

Whereas Russell B. Long served the people of Louisiana with
distinction for 38 years in the United States Senate;

Whereas Russell B. Long served as Chairman of the Com-
mittee on Finance of the United States Senate from
1965 to 1981; and

Whereas Russell B. Long was a tireless and effective cham-
pion for the poor, the disabled, and the elderly: Now,
therefore be it

1 *Resolved*, That the Senate has heard with profound
2 sorrow and deep regret the announcement of the death
3 of the Honorable Russell B. Long, former member of the
4 United States Senate.

5 *Resolved*, That the Secretary of the Senate commu-
6 nicate these resolutions to the House of Representatives
7 and transmit an enrolled copy thereof to the family of the
8 deceased.

9 *Resolved*, That when the Senate adjourns today, it
10 stand adjourned as a further mark of respect to the mem-
11 ory of the Honorable Russell B. Long.
