## RESOLUTION

Eliminating secret Senate holds.

1       *Resolved,*

2       **SECTION 1. ELIMINATING SECRET SENATE HOLDS.**

3       Rule VII of the Standing Rules of the Senate is  
4       amended by adding at the end the following:

5       “7. A Senator who provides notice to party leadership  
6       of his or her intention to object to proceeding to a motion  
7       or matter shall disclose the notice of objection (or hold)  
8       in the Congressional Record in a section reserved for such  
9       notices not later than 2 session days after the date of the  
10      notice.”.
