RESOLUTION

Designating Thursday, November 20, 2003, as “Feed
America Thursday”.

Whereas Thanksgiving Day celebrates the spirit of selfless
giving and an appreciation for family and friends;

Whereas the spirit of Thanksgiving Day is a virtue upon
which our Nation was founded;

Whereas 33,000,000 Americans, including 13,000,000 chil-
dren, continue to live in households that do not have an
adequate supply of food;

Whereas almost 3,000,000 of those children experience hun-
ger; and

Whereas selfless sacrifice breeds a genuine spirit of Thanksgiving, both affirming and restoring fundamental principles in our society: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the Senate—

2 (1) designates Thursday, November 20, 2003,
3 as “Feed America Thursday”; and

4 (2) requests that the President issue a proclamation calling upon the people of the United States
5 to sacrifice 2 meals on Thursday, November 20,
6 2003, and to donate the money that they would have
7 spent on food to a religious or charitable organization of their choice for the purpose of feeding the
8 hungry.
