RESOLUTION

To authorize document production by the Select Committee on Intelligence.

- Whereas the United States Department of Justice has requested that the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence provide it with documents in connection with a pending investigation into the involvement of U.S. government officials in the counter-narcotics air interdiction program in Peru;
- Whereas, by the privileges of the Senate of the United States and rule XI of the Standing Rules of the Senate, no evidence under the control or in the possession of the Senate may, by the judicial or administrative process, be taken from such control or possession but by permission of the Senate; and

Whereas, when it appears that evidence under the control or in the possession of the Senate may promote the administration of justice, the Senate will take such action as will promote the ends of justice consistent with the privileges of the Senate: Now, therefore, be it

Resolved, That the Chairman and Vice Chairman of 1 2 the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence, acting jointly, are authorized to provide to the United States Depart-3 4 ment of Justice, under appropriate security procedures, 5 copies of Committee documents sought in connection with 6 its investigation into the involvement of U.S. government 7 officials in the counter-narcotics air interdiction program 8 in Peru.
