The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution 811, by a nonrecord vote, report the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

SUMMARY PROVISIONS OF THE RESOLUTION

The resolution provides for consideration of H.R. 5183, Surface Transportation Extension Act of 2004, Part V, under a closed rule. The rule provides one hour of debate in the House equally divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.

The rule waives all points of order against consideration of the bill. Finally, the rule provides one motion to recommit.
