An Act

To amend section 220 of the National Housing Act to make a technical correction to restore allowable increases in the maximum mortgage limits for FHA-insured mortgages for multifamily housing projects to cover increased costs of installing a solar energy system or residential energy conservation measures.

**SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

This Act may be cited as the “Energy Efficient Housing Technical Correction Act”.

**SEC. 2. TECHNICAL CORRECTION.**

Section 220(d)(3)(B)(iii)(V) of the National Housing Act (12 U.S.C. 1715k(d)(3)(B)(iii)(V)) is amended by striking “with respect to rehabilitation projects involving not more than five family units,”.
