- 5 26, 2005, or Friday, May 27, 2005, on a motion offered
- 6 pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its Majority
- 7 Leader or his designee, it stand recessed or adjourned
- 8 until noon on Monday, June 6, 2005, or Tuesday, June
- 9 7, 2005, or until such other time on either of those days
- 10 as may be specified by its Majority Leader or his designee
- 11 in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until the time of
- 12 any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent
- 13 resolution, whichever occurs first.
- 14 Sec. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
- 15 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting
- 16 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
- 17 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify
- 18 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,
- 19 to reassemble at such place and time as they may

- 1 designate whenever, in their opinion, the public interest
- 2 shall warrant it.
