- 8 recessed or adjourned until noon on Monday, July 11,
- 9 2005, or at such other time on that day as may be speci-
- 10 fied by its Majority Leader or his designee in the motion
- 11 to recess or adjourn, or until the time of any reassembly
- 12 pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, which-
- 13 ever occurs first.
- 14 Sec. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
- 15 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting
- 16 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
- 17 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify
- 18 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,
- 19 to reassemble at such place and time as they may des-
