## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment of the Senate.

1       *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2   *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-  
3   tive day of Thursday, June 30, 2005, or Friday, July 1,  
4   2005, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent res-  
5   olution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand

1 adjourned until 2 p.m. on Monday, July 11, 2005, or until  
2 the time of any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this  
3 concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first; and that  
4 when the Senate recesses or adjourns on Thursday, June  
5 30, 2005, Friday, July 1, 2005, or Saturday, July 2,  
6 2005, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent res-  
7 olution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand  
8 recessed or adjourned until noon on Monday, July 11,  
9 2005, or at such other time on that day as may be speci-  
10 fied by its Majority Leader or his designee in the motion  
11 to recess or adjourn, or until the time of any reassembly  
12 pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, which-  
13 ever occurs first.

14       SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority  
15 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting  
16 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the  
17 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify  
18 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,  
19 to reassemble at such place and time as they may

- 1 designate whenever, in their opinion, the public interest
- 2 shall warrant it.
