## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To correct technical errors in the enrollment of the bill  
H.R. 3377.

1       *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2       *concurring)*, That, in the enrollment of the bill H.R. 3377,  
3 the Clerk of the House shall make the following correc-  
4 tions in section 5 of the bill:

5               (1) In the matter amending section 157(g)(1)  
6 of title 23, United States Code, strike  
7 “\$92,054,794,521” and insert “\$92,054,794”.

8               (2) In the matter amending section 163(e)(1) of  
9 such title, strike “\$90,410,958,900” and insert  
10 “\$90,410,958”.

1           (3) In the matter amending section 2009(a)(1)  
2 of the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Cen-  
3 tury strike “\$135,616,438,356” and insert  
4 “\$135,616,438”.

5           (4) In the matter amending section 2009(a)(2)  
6 of such Act strike “\$59,178,082,192” and insert  
7 “\$59,178,082”.

8           (5) In the matter amending section 2009(a)(3)  
9 of such Act strike “\$16,438,356,164” and insert  
10 “\$16,438,356”.

11          (6) In the matter amending section 2009(a)(4)  
12 of such Act strike “\$32,876,712,329” and insert  
13 “\$32,876,712”.

14          (7) In the matter amending section 2009(a)(6)  
15 of such Act strike “\$2,958,904,110” and insert  
16 “\$2,958,904”.
