CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment of the Senate.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That, in consonance with section 132(a) of
3 the Legislative Reorganization Act of 1946, when the
4 House adjourns on the legislative day of Thursday, July
5 28, 2005, Friday, July 29, 2005, or Saturday, July 30,

1 2005, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent res-
2 olution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand
3 adjourned until 2 p.m. on Tuesday, September 6, 2005,
4 or until the time of any reassembly pursuant to section
5 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first; and
6 that when the Senate recesses or adjourns on any day
7 from Friday, July 29, 2005, through Friday, August 5,
8 2005, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent res-
9 olution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand
10 recessed or adjourned until noon on Tuesday, September
11 6, 2005, or at such other time on that day as may be
12 specified by its Majority Leader or his designee in the mo-
13 tion to recess or adjourn, or until the time of any re-
14 assembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolu-
15 tion, whichever occurs first.

16 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
17 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting
18 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
19 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify
20 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,
21 to reassemble at such place and time as they may

- 1 designate whenever, in their opinion, the public interest
- 2 shall warrant it.
