- 8 or his designee, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon
- 9 on Monday, December 12, 2005, or Tuesday, December
- 10 13, 2005, or until such other time on either of those days,
- 11 as may be specified by its Majority Leader or his designee
- 12 in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until the time of
- 13 any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent
- 14 resolution, whichever occurs first.
- 15 Sec. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
- 16 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting
- 17 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
