## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment of the Senate.

1       *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2   *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-  
3   tive day of Friday, November 18, 2005, or Saturday, No-  
4   vember 19, 2005, on a motion offered pursuant to this  
5   concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his

1 designee, it stand adjourned until 2 p.m. on Tuesday, De-  
2 cember 6, 2005, or until the time of any reassembly pursu-  
3 ant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever  
4 occurs first; and that when the Senate recesses or ad-  
5 journs on any day from Friday, November 18, 2005,  
6 through Wednesday, November 23, 2005, on a motion of-  
7 fered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its Major-  
8 ity Leader or his designee, it stand recessed or adjourned  
9 until noon on Monday, December 12, 2005, or Tuesday,  
10 December 13, 2005, or until such other time on either  
11 of those days, as may be specified by its Majority Leader  
12 or his designee in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until  
13 the time of any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this  
14 concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

15       SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority  
16 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting  
17 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the  
18 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify  
19 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,  
20 to reassemble at such place and time as they may

1 designate if, in their opinion, the public interest shall war-  
2 rant it.
