- 4 ate recesses or adjourns on any day from Friday, Feb-
- 5 ruary 17, 2006, through Tuesday, February 21, 2006, on
- 6 a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution
- 7 by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand recessed
- 8 or adjourned until noon on Monday, February 27, 2006,
- 9 or such other time on that day as may be specified by
- 10 its Majority Leader or his designee in the motion to recess
- 11 or adjourn, or until the time of any reassembly pursuant
- 12 to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs
- 13 first.
- 14 Sec. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
- 15 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting
- 16 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
- 17 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify
- 18 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,
- 19 to reassemble at such place and time as they may des-

1 ignate if, in their opinion, the public interest shall warrant

2 it.
