- 8 journed until noon on Monday, March 27, 2006, or such
- 9 other time on that day as may be specified by its Majority
- 10 Leader or his designee in the motion to recess or adjourn,
- 11 or until the time of any reassembly pursuant to section
- 12 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.
- 13 Sec. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
- 14 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting
- 15 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
- 16 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify
