## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment of the Senate.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-  
3 tive day of Thursday, March 16, 2006, on a motion offered  
4 pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its Majority  
5 Leader or his designee, it stand adjourned until 2 p.m.

1 on Tuesday, March 28, 2006, or until the time of any re-  
2 assembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolu-  
3 tion, whichever occurs first; and that when the Senate re-  
4 cesses or adjourns on Thursday, March 16, 2006, Friday,  
5 March 17, 2006, or Saturday, March 18, 2006, on a mo-  
6 tion offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its  
7 Majority Leader or his designee, it stand recessed or ad-  
8 journed until noon on Monday, March 27, 2006, or such  
9 other time on that day as may be specified by its Majority  
10 Leader or his designee in the motion to recess or adjourn,  
11 or until the time of any reassembly pursuant to section  
12 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

13       SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority  
14 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting  
15 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the  
16 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify  
17 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,  
18 to reassemble at such place and time as they may des-  
19 ignate if, in their opinion, the public interest shall warrant  
20 it.
