CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the printing as a House document of United States House of Representatives, The Committee on Ways and Means: A History, 1789–2006.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. PRINTING OF DOCUMENT.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The document entitled “United
5 States House of Representatives, The Committee on Ways
6 and Means: A History, 1789–2006”, prepared under the

1 direction of the Office of the Historian, United States
2 House of Representatives, shall be printed as a House doc-
3 ument, with illustrations and suitable binding, in a style
4 and manner determined by the Joint Committee on Print-
5 ing.

6 (b) ADDITIONAL COPIES.—With respect to the docu-
7 ment described in subsection (a), in addition to the usual
8 number there shall be printed the lesser of—

9 (1) 1,500 copies, of which 50 shall be bound in
10 leather for the use of Members of the Committee on
11 Ways and Means and 500 shall be casebound for
12 distribution by the Committee on Ways and Means;
13 or

14 (2) the maximum number of copies for which
15 the total production and printing cost does not ex-
16 ceed \$40,000, with production and distribution to be
17 allocated in the same proportion as described in
18 paragraph (1).
