 3 SECTION 1. REQUIRING AMOUNTS REMAINING IN MEM4 BERS' REPRESENTATIONAL ALLOWANCES TO
 5 BE USED FOR DEFICIT REDUCTION OR TO RE6 DUCE THE FEDERAL DEBT.
 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
- 8 sion of law, any amounts appropriated for Members' Rep-

- 1 resentational Allowances for the House of Representatives
- 2 for a fiscal year which remain after all payments are made
- 3 under such Allowances for the year shall be deposited in
- 4 the Treasury and used for deficit reduction, except that
- 5 in the case of a fiscal year for which there is no Federal
- 6 budget deficit, such amounts shall be used to reduce the
- 7 Federal debt (in such manner as the Secretary of the
- 8 Treasury considers appropriate).
- 9 (b) Effective Date.—This section shall apply with
- 10 respect to fiscal year 2005 and each succeeding fiscal year.
