1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. CERTAIN RESTRICTED AIR SPACE WAIVER.

4 Section 521(a)(2) of the Transportation, Treasury,
5 and Independent Agencies Appropriations Act, 2004
6 (Public Law 108–199, div. F) is amended—

7 (1) by striking "and" at the end of subpara8 graph (B)(v);

(2) by striking the period at the end of sub-1 2 paragraph (C) and inserting the following: "; and"; 3 and (3) by adding at the end the following: 4 "(D) to allow the operation of an aircraft 5 participating in an air show in restricted air-6 space if the Administrator of the Federal Avia-7 tion Administration, in consultation with the 8 9 Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security, determines that the safety of an event is 10 not compromised.". 11
