To allow a waiver or exemption of certain requirements for restricted airspace if security is not reduced.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN RESTRICTED AIR SPACE WAIVER.**

4 Section 521(a)(2) of the Transportation, Treasury,
5 and Independent Agencies Appropriations Act, 2004
6 (Public Law 108–199, div. F) is amended—

7 (1) by striking “and” at the end of subpara-
8 graph (B)(v);

1 (2) by striking the period at the end of sub-
2 paragraph (C) and inserting the following: “; and”;
3 and

4 (3) by adding at the end the following:

5 “(D) to allow the operation of an aircraft
6 participating in an air show in restricted air-
7 space if the Administrator of the Federal Avia-
8 tion Administration, in consultation with the
9 Secretary of the Department of Homeland Se-
10 curity, determines that the safety of an event is
11 not compromised.”.
