## A BILL

To amend title 5, United States Code, to increase the mandatory retirement age for members of the Capitol Police from 57 to 60 years of age.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. INCREASE IN MANDATORY RETIREMENT AGE.**

4       (a) CIVIL SERVICE RETIREMENT SYSTEM.—Section  
5       8335(c) of title 5, United States Code, is amended—

6               (1) in the first sentence by striking “57” and  
7       inserting “60”; and

1           (2) in the second sentence by striking “60” and  
2       inserting “65”.

3       (b) FEDERAL EMPLOYEES’ RETIREMENT SYSTEM.—  
4       Section 8425(c) of title 5, United States Code, is amend-  
5       ed—

6           (1) in the first sentence by striking “57” and  
7       inserting “60”; and

8           (2) in the second sentence by striking “60” and  
9       inserting “65”.
